State law (T.C.A. 49-6-5002) requires child care facilities and schools through 12th grade to accept only an Official Immunization Certificate provided by the Department of Health, completed and signed by a physician or health care provider administering immunizations, as proof of immunization for enrollment purposes. Official certificates may be completed by local health departments or by a Tennessee health care provider. It is not acceptable to staple records to a copy of the official certificate or to use any unofficial version of a certificate for enrollment (<http://health.state.tn.us/Ceds/immunization.htm>).

**Note:** Color of the school certificate is not required, as long as they have the state seal and the state-issued public health (PH-) form number in the bottom left corner.
